



HOW TO WRITE ADDRESS ON E-INVOICE FROM 01/07/2025

From 01/7/2025, Vietnam will begin to adjust administrative boundaries and deploy a two-level local government model according to Resolution 202/2025/QH15.



Regarding business registration, taxpayers are not required to update the administrative boundary information on the Enterprise Registration Certificate.



Taxpayers are not required to update their tax registration information. The tax authorities will automatically standardize the registered address based on the new administrative boundary data from the national database.



The addresses of the seller and the buyer must be recorded in accordance with the information in the Business Registration and Tax Registration databases.

Create E-Invoices via the Tax Authority's Service Portal

The system has been standardized to the new address.

Create Electronic Invoice via Solution Provider

The solution provider is responsible for standardizing the taxpayer/customer address according to the new administrative boundaries.



In case the solution provider has not updated in time

It is still allowed to use the old address if the Enterprise Registration Certificate still shows the old address.
